

Pete Churchill:

As a pianist, Pete spent 15 years as accompanist to the legendary Jazz singer Mark Murphy and, more recently worked with Sheila Jordan. He has been a member of both Kenny Wheeler's and Abdullah Ibrahim's Vocal Projects and had the privilege of being conductor of the Kenny Wheeler Big Band, culminating in the final album, 'The Long Waiting'.

Pete is also recognised internationally as a musician who facilitates ground-breaking choral collaborations in Jazz. As founder/director of 'The London Vocal Project' (LVP), he has spearheaded projects with Bobby McFerrin, Sir John Dankworth & Dame Cleo Laine, Kenny Wheeler and Norma Winstone MBE. A critically acclaimed CD 'Mirrors' with Ken Norma was recorded with LVP In 2017 and after a lengthy collaboration with the legendary Jazz singer/lyricist Jon Hendricks, Pete and LVP - sponsored by Quincy Jones – travelled to New York to give the world premiere of Hendricks' 'Miles Ahead'.
