Sandra Oberoi gave her first solo public performance at the age of three. She has since performed and taught around India, the United States, Canada, across the African continent, Russia, the United Kingdom and in parts of Europe, sharing the message of hope, joy and love through her songs and challenging people to pursue excellence in their artistic calling.

Some of her performance highlights include representing India with her daughters, Tiara and Tiana at the Global Hope Festival - an online Classical Music Concert to raise funds for World Health Organization's Covid Response Fund; singing at the International Womens' Festival in Nairobi; performing at the World Paralympics Mascot Launch opening ceremony; collaborating with the highest selling gospel artist Don Moen. She is regularly featured on Indian national television and radio, has been a soloist with the Northwestern University Summer Chorus, U.S.A., and performed with several artists across the globe. Sandra offers voice masterclass and teaches on various topics including vocal health, singing techniques for soloists and choir and nurturing adolescent voices.

She founded '[Harmony - The Music School](#)' close to 13 years ago, offering high quality music training for children and adults. Eight students won international singing competitions and have performed at Carnegie Hall in New York City. Her students have excelled in their international music examinations scoring the highest marks in India for Classical Singing and Musical Theatre. Many have gone on to pursue music degrees at Oxford, Berklee College of Music, National University of Singapore, Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Dance, The London College of Music and Temple University.

The Harmony Chorus:

Sandra is the Artistic Director of India's award winning youth choir 'The Harmony Chorus'. In 2018, the choir placed in India's Top 8 on 'Rising Star Season 2', a national level reality singing show on Indian television. THC has traveled on concert tours in Russia, England and Scotland and won the Award for Choral Excellence at the UK Choir Festival in 2019.



Social Projects:

Sandra co-founded 'The Harmony International Music Foundation', a not-for-profit organisation that facilitates concerts and recitals with unique themes, featuring The Harmony Chorus and artists from around the world. Through these concerts, the foundation has supported children with AIDS, mentally and physically challenged children, funded the education of lesser-privileged children, and supported old age homes and orphanages in Bangalore city.

Sandra actively campaigns for the advancement of music education in India and around the world. She continues to encourage young musicians to pursue excellence in their craft and use their musical gift for the greater good.
